

Chapter 10.20MUFFLERSSections:

10.20.010 Required--Penalty for violation.

10.20.010 Required--Penalty for violation. A. It is unlawful for any person to drive any motor vehicle within the corporate limits of the village without a muffler upon the motor vehicle, or drive said motor vehicle within the limits of the village with the muffler of the motor vehicle cut out.

B. Any person found guilty of violating subsection A of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined the sum of one dollar and costs of suit, upon the second conviction for this offense shall be fined the sum of two dollars and costs of suit, and for each succeeding offense shall be fined not less than five dollars and costs of suit. (§1 of Ord. dated 7/20/18).

10.24.010 Definitions. The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this chapter:

A. "Person" means any person, firm, partnership, association, corporation, company or organization of any kind.

B. "Property" means any real property within the village which is not a street or highway.

C. "Street or highway" means the entire width between the boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when

any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

D. "Vehicle" means a machine propelled by power other than human power, designed to travel along the ground by use of wheels, treads, runners or slides and transport persons or property or pull machinery, and includes, without limitation, automobile, truck, trailer, motorcycle, tractor, buggy and wagon. (§1 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

10.24.020 Abandonment prohibited. No person shall abandon any vehicle within the village and no person shall leave any vehicle at any place within the village for such time and under such circumstances as to cause such vehicle reasonably to appear to have been abandoned. (§2 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

10.24.030 Wrecked or nonoperating vehicle--Leaving prohibited. No person shall leave any partially dismantled, nonoperating, wrecked or junked vehicle on any street or highway within the village. (§3 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

10.24.040 Wrecked or nonoperating vehicle--Disposition. No person in charge or control of any property within the village, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee or otherwise, shall allow any partially dismantled, nonoperating, wrecked, junked or discarded vehicle to remain on such property longer than forty-eight hours; and no person shall leave any such vehicle on any property within the village for a longer time than forty-eight hours; except that this chapter shall not apply with regard to a vehicle in an enclosed building, a vehicle on the premises of a business enterprise operated in a lawful place and manner, when necessary to the operation of such business enterprise, or a vehicle in an appropriate storage place or depository maintained in a lawful place and manner by the village. (§4 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

10.24.050 Impoundment authorized. The chief of police or any member of his department designated by him is authorized to remove or have removed any vehicle left at any place within the village which reasonably appears to be in violation of this chapter or lost, stolen or unclaimed. Such vehicle shall be impounded until lawfully claimed or disposed of in accordance with Chapter 95-1/2 Illinois Revised Statutes 1965, paragraphs 42-49. (§5 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

10.24.060 Penalty for violation. Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an

amount not exceeding five hundred dollars. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue constitutes a separate offense, and is punishable as such under this chapter. (§6 of Ord. dated 7/5/66).

Chapter 10.28

BICYCLES\*

Sections:

10.28.010 Riding on walks and sidewalks prohibited--

10.28.020 Penalty for violation.

10.28.010 Riding on walks and sidewalks prohibited--  
Exception. A. It is unlawful for any person, male or female, to ride a bicycle on any walk or sidewalk within the corporate limits of the village.

B. The police are not required to enforce this chapter against persons riding with reasonable care and diligence. (Amendment dated 5/7/1906; §1 of Ord. dated 5/15/05).

10.28.020 Penalty for violation. Any person who violates Section 10.28.010, for the first offense shall be fined not exceeding one dollar and for the second offense shall be fined the sum of five dollars. (§2 of Ord. dated 5/15/05).
