CURBS AND GUTTERS\*

12.12.010 Petition to make improvement. A. Whenever a petition is filed with the village clerk, signed by the owners of land representing more than one-half of the frontage of either or both sides of one or more blocks, it shall be the duty of the clerk to notify the property owners on the street or streets named in the petition to make the improvement within thirty days as described in said petition.

B. If any property owner fails to complete said improvement within thirty days, it shall be the duty of the officer in charge of the streets to proceed to have the work done, the expense to be levied against said improved property.

C. The petition shall describe the style and width of parking, curbs and gutters and the kind and number of trees to be planted. (§1 of Ord. dated 4/6/03).

12.12.020 Uniform parking required--Animals prohibited on parking. A. The parking on all blocks of any one street shall be uniform in style and width.

B. Riding, driving or leading animals on street parking is prohibited under penalty of fine of not less than ten nor more than twenty dollars for each offense. (§2 of Ord. dated 4/6/03).

12.12.030 Telephone and electric-light poles. All telephone and electric-light poles that may be put after the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter shall be on the curb line or one foot within said line and, on request, the street commissioner shall lay out and establish such lines. (§3 of Ord. dated 4/6/03).
