ORDINANCE NO. 82-1

An Ordinance Establishing Snow Emergency Routes

WHEREAS, vehicles parked on streets hereinafter referred to may interfere with and obstruct the delivery of police, fire and other emergency services during snow storms; and further, interfere with and obstruct removal of snow on those streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois, as follows:

1. That the following streets in the Village of Tolono are hereby designated as Snow Routes:
 - a. Main Street between Vorcey and Bourne Streets
 - b. Vorcey Street between Main and Holden Streets
 - c. Holden Street between the Railroad and Bourne Street
 - d. Bourne Street between Main and Walnut Streets
 - e. Walnut Street between the Railroad and Central Street
 - f. Washington Street between Bourne and Central Streets
 - g. Central Street between Washington Street and River Road
2. That there shall be no parking on either side of the streets designated as Snow Routes six hours after a two-inch snowfall has accumulated on such Snow Routes.
3. That parking will be permitted on said Snow Routes immediately following removal of the snow, subject to other applicable ordinances.
4. That vehicles parking on Snow Routes in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to being towed, and may be reclaimed upon payment of towing and storage fees, if any.

5. That the Village Inspector is hereby authorized to place and establish appropriate signs or other devices in accord with sound traffic engineering principles to designate said Snow Routes and restrictions; said signage shall not be required, however, to enforce this ordinance.

6. That the President of the Village Board, the Chief of Police, the Village Inspector, or their designated assistant, are authorized to advise the public (either on a person to person basis, by local media, or by posting a notice at the Village Hall), at the beginning of any six-hour period after at least two inches of snowfall has accumulated on said Snow Routes, and of the intent of the Village to remove the snow and to tow vehicles parked thereon in violation of this Ordinance.

7. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten days after its passage and publication.
