ORDINANCE NUMBER 89-5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC-CONTROL
REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 10,
SECTION 12 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE)

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Champaign County, Illinois, that the provisions of Chapter 10, Section 12 of the Municipal Code entitled "Traffic Control Regulations" shall be amended in the following particulars:

Section 10.12.040 Provisions and Regulations for Stopping at Designated Intersections. In addition to the traffic controls set forth in the current Ordinance, the following shall also apply:

84. That traffic approaching Condit Street from the East on Holden Street, and traffic approaching Holden Street from the South on Condit in the Village of Tolono, shall come to a full stop where said Streets intersect.

All other provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect subject only to the addition of the aforesaid requirement to stop at the intersection as indicated.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be effective upon passage.


