ORDINANCE NO. 90-5 TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS FOR 1990-1991

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono,
County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 17th day of
July, A.D., 1990, pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance
for said Village of Tolono, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning
on the first day of May, 1990, and ending on April 30, 1991, the
amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of
\$1,327,300.00 (excluding principal and interest for retirement of
Waterworks and Sewerage Revenue Bonds hereinafter noted), which said
budget and appropriation bill was duly published as provided by law;
and,

WHEREAS, \$1,232,650.00 will be received from sources other than taxes, leaving the total amount of \$94,650.00 to be received from levy of taxes for said year for the following purposes and funds:

Section 1: That there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon all taxable property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of said Village of Tolono, Illinois, for the revenue year, A.D., 1990-1991, the total sum of \$94,650.00 for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:

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Section 2: In addition to the budget and appropriation detailed above, retirement of bonded indebtedness is required for the waterworks and sewerage revenue bonds as follows:

\$925,000.00 waterworks and sewerage revenue refunding bonds, series 1987, require a principal payment of \$35,000.00 and an estimated interest payment in the amount of \$73,200.00 both payable in 1991

That in addition to the foregoing, there is levied the following: For interest on bonded indebtedness in payment of maturing general obligation bonds, 1971 issue as per Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE Providing for Borrowing Money and Issuing Bonds of the Village of Tolono, Champaign County, Illinois, to the amount of \$245,000.00 for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer system in and for said Village, and providing for the levy in collection of a direct annual tax for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds", a certified copy of which is on file with the County Clerk, estimated at \$21,100.00.

Section 3: The clerk of said Village of Tolono is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of said County, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
