

ORDINANCE NO. 92-5
ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
of the
VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS

An ordinance making appropriations for the corporate purposes of the VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 1992, and ending on April 30, 1993.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TOLONO, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1:

That the following sums, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes of the VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS, to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of said VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS, as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 1992, and ending on April 30, 1992, to-wit:

SECTION 2:

In addition to the items budgeted for the above funds, retirement is required for General Obligation Bonds, Series 1990 (Waterworks and Sewerage Alternate Revenue Service) in the amount of \$1,135,000.00. Said bonds require principal and interest payments by levy through the County Clerk, unless the Board of Trustees files an abatement.

At this time, the Board of Trustees plans on collecting adequate Water and Sewerage charges to meet said obligations as required by said bonds, and as set forth in an ordinance on file with the Champaign County Clerk.

SECTION 3:

The said several sums of money are hereby appropriated from monies received and to be received by the VILLAGE OF TOLONO, from all sources, and nothing set forth herein shall prohibit transfers from one Village fund to another provided such monies are disbursed in compliance with law, this ordinance and subsequent tax levies.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in lawful pamphlet form.
