ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN STOP SIGNS

WHEREAS:

A. The Village of Tolono, Illinois has heretofore adopted ordinances establishing through streets within the Village limits; and,

B. The Village of Tolono has the authority to regulate vehicular traffic within the Village limits, and to determine the required operation of vehicular traffic at street intersections; and,

C. The Village of Tolono has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village of Tolono and its residents, and will promote vehicular safety if stop signs are erected at a certain street intersection within the Village limits, in addition to those intersections where stop signs have heretofore been erected.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS, THAT

1. MAIN/ELIZABETH,

At the intersection of Main Street, an East/West street, and Elizabeth Street, a North/South street, Northbound traffic on Elizabeth, Southbound traffic on Elizabeth, and Westbound traffic on Main and Eastbound traffic on Main approaching said intersection shall stop at but before entering the intersection and shall proceed to enter said intersection only when it is safe to do so.

2. BROADWAY/ELIZABETH.

BROADWY

At the intersection of Elizabeth Street, a North/South Street, and Main Street, an East/West Street, all Northbound traffic on Elizabeth, Southbound traffic on Elizabeth, Eastbound traffic on Main, and Westbound traffic on Main Streets shall stop at but before entering the intersection and shall proceed to enter said intersection only when it is safe to do so.

3. LOCUST/CENTRAL

At the intersection of Locust Street, an East/West Street, and Central Street, a North/South Street, all Eastbound traffic on Locust and all Westbound traffic on Locust shall stop at but before entering the intersection and shall proceed to enter said intersection only when it is safe to do so.

4. OTHER INTERSECTIONS.

This Ordinance establishes through streets and required stops only at those intersections specifically addressed. It is not a comprehensive traffic regulation ordinance. All prior ordinances regarding traffic regulations, through streets, required stops and stop signs, except as specifically amended in this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect.

5. STOP SIGNS.

Stop signs shall be erected at said intersections pursuant to this Ordinance, in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

6. VIOLATIONS.

Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00, which may be imposed by a court of competent jurisdiction, or if the Village authorities so determine, and the violator pays voluntarily, by an administratively imposed fine.

7. PUBLICATION.

The Village Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication in accordance with law.
