VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WHITEHEAD STREET ORDINANCE NO. 01-06

WHEREAS, the Village of Tolono Planning Commission in a meeting held June 28, 2001 has considered and recommended that a certain portion of Whitehead Street be vacated with its findings incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has deemed it appropriate to vacate same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That portion of Whitehead Street situated in Tolono, Illinois and adjacent to the following described properties is hereby vacated, contingent upon each owner paying the fee provided herein and executing an easement document:

Whitehead Street between Lot 1 in Block 79 and Lot 5 in Block 31 of Smith and Company's Addition to Tolono, south of Austin Street to the North Line of Great Western Avenue.

SECTION 2: Adjacent property owners shall each reimburse the Village the sum of \$250.00 per lot in order to acquire title to the vacated land.

SECTION 3: Each lot owner shall execute an easement document granting access to the Village attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication in accordance with law.
