AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC-CONTROL REGULATIONS PROVIDING FOR STOP SIGNS AT FOURTH AND LARMON AND SECOND AND BROADWAY STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Village Board of Trustees of Tolono, Illinois, that pursuant to Chapter 10, Section 12 of the Municipal Code entitled "Traffic Control Regulations" Section 10.12.040 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Tolono, together with other applicable ordinances and statutes, stop signs shall be erected at the following locations:

<u>Fourth & Larmon</u>. There shall be stop signs on Fourth Street for north bound traffic and for south bound traffic where Fourth Street intersects with Larmon Street. There shall be stop signs on Larmon Street for east bound traffic and for west bound traffic where Fourth Street intersects all as situated in Tolono, Illinois.

<u>Second & Broadway</u>. There shall be stop signs on Second Street for north bound traffic and for south bound traffic where Second Street intersects with Broadway Street. There shall be stop signs on Broadway Street for east bound traffic for west bound traffic where Broadway Street intersects with Second Street all as situated in Tolono, Illinois.

All other provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect subject only to the addition of the aforesaid requirement to stop at the above described intersections as indicated.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be effective upon passage.
