AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC-CONTROL
REGULATIONS
REMOVING STOP SIGNS AT
BENHAM AND THIRD STREETS
AND ADDING STOP SIGNS
AT BENHAM AND FOURTH STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Village Board of Trustees of Tolono, Illinois, that pursuant to Chapter 10, Section 12 of the Municipal Code entitled "Traffic Control Regulations" Section 10.12.040 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Tolono, together with other applicable ordinances and statutes, stop signs shall be erected at the following locations:

BENHAM & THIRD STREETS. The stop signs on Benham Street for East bound traffic and for West bound traffic where Third Street intersects with Benham Street shall be removed.

BENHAM & FOURTH STREETS. There shall be stop signs on Benham Street for East bound traffic and for West bound traffic where Fourth Street intersects with Benham Street. There shall be a stop sign on Fourth Street for South bound traffic where Fourth Street intersects all as situated in Tolono, Illinois.

All other provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect subject only to the addition of the aforesaid requirement at the above described intersections as indicated.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be effective upon passage.
