ORDINANCE NO. 2005-____ TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS FOR 2005-2006

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, County of Champaign and State of Illinois, did on the 5th day of July, A. D., 2005, pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, for said Village of Tolono, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of May, 2005 and ending on April 30, 2006, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$1,627,450.00 which said budget and appropriation bill was duly published as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, \$1,501,208.00 will be received from sources other than real estate taxes, leaving the total amount of \$126,242.00 to be received from levy of taxes for said year for the following purposes and funds:

WHEREAS, consideration of the within ordinance and all other matters was made pursuant to applicable law at a duly held public meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois:

Section 1: That there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon all taxable property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of said Village of Tolono, Illinois, for the revenue year A. D., 2005-2006, the total sum of \$126,242.00 for the following specific purposes mentioned in said appropriation bill and in the respective sums as follows, to-wit:
