ORDINANCE NO. 06-_____
PROHIBITING BLOCKING
PUBLIC SIDEWALKS
within the
VILLAGE OF TOLONO, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, County of Champaign and State of Illinois, is charged with the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and
WHEREAS, The Village of Tolono is authorized to regulate public right of ways and traffic within Village Boundaries; and
WHEREAS, The Village of Tolono, pursuant to duly held public meetings by its Board of Trustees, has determined it appropriate and necessary to restrict parking which blocks Village sidewalks as provided by this ordinance.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

No vehicle shall be parked so as to impinge upon or otherwise block the public sidewalks within the Village of Tolono, Illinois.

Violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of \$_____ with each day of violation constituting a separate violation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois:

The Village Clerk shall use a copy of the within Ordinance, signed by the Village President indicating his approval and attested by the Village Clerk, to be filed with the County Clerk, Champaign County, Illinois.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication in lawful pamphlet form.
