AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LOADING ZONE IN THE VILLAGE ALLEYWAY

ORDINANCE NO. 06-_____

WHEREAS, the Village of Tolono, Illinois by its Board of Trustees is charged with the health, care and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, has the authority to regulate parking and traffic on public roadways including but not limited to its alleyways; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to consideration of the impact of traffic and use of a certain alleyway existing between Walnut Street and Vine Street in the Village of Tolono, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary and appropriate to proceed with prohibiting parking therein as provided for under this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained as follows:

The parking of vehicles in the Village Alleyway located between Walnut Street and Vine Street is hereby prohibited except for temporary parking in the designated Loading Zone once for a period not to exceed 30 minutes per day. Parking outside of the Loading Zone or more than once or more than 30 minutes per day in the Loading Zone is prohibited and shall constitute a violation of this Ordinance. Violation of this Ordinance shall subject the defending owner of such vehicle to incur the initial fine of \$25.00 and such vehicle shall be subject to being towed from the premises with all costs of same being born by the owner of the vehicle. In the event that the owner of such vehicle violates this Ordinance more than once in a one year period, then for each subsequent violation, the fines provided herein shall be in the amount of \$75.00 for each such offense.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage, approval and publication in lawful pamphlet form.
