TOLONO, ILLINOIS AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO AS IT RELATES TO POLITICAL ELECTION SIGNS ORDINANCE NO. 07-_____

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Champaign County, Illinois, previously adopted the Revised Code of Ordinances as may have been subsequently amended, defines and determines the requirements regarding Tolono; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and President have determined, at a public hearing held this date during a duly held regular meeting, that it is appropriate to adopt the within ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois, that:

- 1. Section 8.4.7 Political Election Signs: is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - A. No political election signs may be placed on any property without the permission of the owner of said property.
 - B. The location and number of political signs in and around polling places shall be in accordance with Federal, State, and County laws, rules and regulations.
 - C. The maximum size of any one sign shall be thirty two square feet.
 - D. No political election sign shall be erected prior to thirty days before an election.
 - E. All political election signs shall be removed four days following an election.

2. To the extent that the within Ordinance conflicts with the Revised Code of Ordinances as provided herein, the terms of the within Ordinance shall prevail. All other portions of this Ordinance not otherwise amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect as previously amended.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
