### AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TRAFFIC-CONTROL REGULATIONS PROVIDING FOR A THREE WAY STOP SIGN WITHIN THE DEERPATH SUBDIVISION WINDSTONE SUBDIVISION

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Village Board of Trustees of Tolono, Illinois, that pursuant to Chapter 10, Section 12 of the Municipal Code entitled "Traffic Control Regulations" Section 10.12.040 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Tolono, together with other applicable ordinances and statutes, stop signs shall be erected at the following locations:

<u>WINDSTONE DRIVE AND DEERPATH DRIVE.</u> There shall be a three way stop located on Windstone Drive and Deerpath Drive with traffic traveling North stopping where it intersects with Deerpath Drive with traffic on Deerpath traveling East and West stopping where it intersects with Windstone Drive, all as situated in Tolono, Illinois.

All other provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect subject only to the addition of the aforesaid requirement to stop at the above described intersections as indicated.

Effective this date and published in pamphlet form in accordance with Illinois Law.

**THIS ORDINANCE** shall be effective upon passage.
