

Chapter 5.12PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, AUCTIONEERS AND SHOWMEN*Sections:

- 5.12.010 License--Required.
- 5.12.020 License--Fee.
- 5.12.030 License--Issuance.
- 5.12.040 Violation of Section 5.12.010 deemed misdemeanor--Penalty.

5.12.010 License--Required. It is unlawful for any hawker, peddler or auctioneer of goods, merchandise or materials of any or all kinds to sell or in any manner dispose of such goods or merchandise or materials or any part thereof within the limits of the village without first having obtained license to do so, nor shall it be lawful for any theatrical, concert or other exhibition, circus, show or amusement to exhibit, locate or perform within the limits of the village, or within one half mile outside of corporation limits, unless such keeper or keepers have first obtained a license for that purpose. (§1 of Ord. dated 5/20/1878).

5.12.020 License--Fee. The amount of the license required by Section 5.12.010 shall be as follows:

- A. For circuses, ten dollars per day;
- B. For nonresident auctioneers, three dollars for the first day and two dollars for each succeeding day;
- C. For a theatrical, concert or other exhibition where the fee of admission is fifty cents, two dollars per day, and where the fee for admission is less than fifty cents, five dollars per day;
- D. For retail peddlers, not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars per day. (Amended 5/15/05; §2 of Ord. dated 5/30/1878).

5.12.030 License--Issuance. The board of trustees may, by order or resolution, provide for any officer of the village to issue license to any person or persons applying for the same under this chapter; provided that in no case shall

any license under this chapter be issued unless the applicant has actually paid the amount fixed in Section 5.12.020 for such license. (§4 of Ord. dated 5/30/1878).

5.12.040 Violation of section 5.12.010 deemed misdemeanor--Penalty. Any person or persons violating Section 5.12.010, whether as agent or principal or otherwise, directly or indirectly, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, for each and every offense, forfeit and pay a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars. (§3 of Ord. dated 5/30/1878).
