between the hours of eleven p.m. on Saturday and twelve noon on the following Sunday, shall be in disturbance of the peace and quiet of the village and shall be subject to the fine provided in Section 9.12.010. (\S 2 of Ord. dated 11/2/53).

9.12.030 Operation of radios, televisions and similar devices. Any person, firm or corporation who employs or allows to the employed on his premises, or on premises leased or controlled by him, any radio, television set, loudspeaker, public address system, music box, or other device which omits from said premises any loud or unusual noise between the hours of ten p.m. and eight a.m. of the following day on each weekday, and between the hours of eleven p.m. on Saturday and twelve noon on the following Sunday shall be in disturbance of the peace and quiet of the village and shall be subject to the fine provided in Section 9.12.010. (§3 of Ord. dated 11/2/53).

Chapter 9.16

UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY*

Sections:

- 9.16.010 Collecting and failure do disperse--Penalty.
- 9.16.010 Collecting and failure to disperse--Penalty. All persons who collect in crowds within the village for unlawful purposes or for any purpose to the annoyance or disturbance of citizens or travelers are subject to a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars and to a further fine of not more than fifty dollars upon refusing to disperse after being requested to do so by any village officer. (§5 of Ord. dated 5/13/1878).
