9.20.010 Penalty. Any person who disturbs or disquiets any congregation or assembly met for religious worship or any other lawful purpose, by making any noise, or by rude or indecent behavior, or by profane, obscene or improper discourse in conduct within the sight or hearing of such congregation of assembly shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than fifty dollars. 9.24.010 Penalty. Whoever, within the limits of the village, disturbs the peace and good order of society by labor or amusement on Sunday, work of necessity and charity excepted, shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than twenty-five dollars. (§7 of Ord. dated 5/13/1878).
